

4 CSR 240-2.080(15) provides that parties are allowed not more than ten days in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. More than

ten days have passed since the STCG filed its motion for leave to file *amicus curiae* comments and no party has responded to that motion.

The STCG's motion for leave to file *amicus curiae* comments is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. That motion will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Small Telephone Company Group is granted leave to file *amicus curiae* comments regarding Comcast IP Phone, LLC's motion to dismiss.
2. This order shall become effective on November 29, 2006.
