ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO
MOTION FOR EXPEDITED RULING

On June 14, 2007, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, filed a Motion for Expedited Ruling on Respondent's Pending Motion to Dismiss and Motion for Summary Determination. Therein, Respondents express dissatisfaction that the Commission has yet to rule on their motion to dismiss filed on April 2, and claim they are entitled to a ruling on that motion "without further delay." Further, they submit an additional Motion for Summary Determination, and ask for responses from Socket Telecom, LLC, no later than June 22.

Given the history of immediate and rancorous exchanges between the parties in this case, the Commission hardly finds it necessary to order Socket to expeditiously

respond. However, the Commission will nonetheless order its Staff and Socket Telecom to respond to CenturyTel's June 14 pleading by the date requested.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission and Socket Telecom, LLC are ordered to file pleadings as described above, no later than June 22, 2007.
2. This order shall become effective on June 15, 2007.
