**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO MODIFY  
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On December 14, 2007, the Commission's Staff, on behalf of all the parties to this case, filed a joint motion to modify the procedural schedule. Staff notes that there is only one remaining issue in this case, which is Timber Creek's request to change the amount of the Contributions in Aid of Construction connection fee. Staff relates that the parties have been negotiating on this issue and expect to continue negotiations through the coming week. Staff states that if an agreement is reached, there will be no need to file testimony in this case. Therefore, the parties request that the Commission extend the filing date for Timber Creek's and Staff's direct testimony to December 21, 2007, and extend the filing date for Hunt Midwest Real Estate Development, Inc.'s and the Office of the Public Counsel's rebuttal testimony to January 18, 2008. The parties propose that the rest of the procedural schedule remain in effect, unchanged.

The Commission has considered the motion and finds it is reasonable to extend the filing dates as requested by the parties. All other procedural dates will remain in effect.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Joint Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule is granted.

2. No later than December 21, 2007, Timber Creek Sewer Company and the Staff of the Commission shall file their direct testimony.
3. No later than January 18, 2008, Hunt Midwest Real Estate Development, Inc., and the Office of the Public Counsel shall file their rebuttal testimony.
4. The remainder of the procedural schedule in this case remains unchanged.
5. This order shall become effective on December 14, 2007.
