On January 18, 2008, the Office of the Public Counsel, on behalf of all the parties, filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule. OPC notes that on January 4, 2008, a unanimous stipulation was filed which stated that the parties have reached an agreement that resolves all issues with respect to the contributions in aid of construction (CIAC) connection fee, which is the only remaining issue in this case. OPC therefore requests that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule while it considers the parties' unanimous stipulation.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Office of the Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule is granted.
2. The remainder of the procedural schedule is suspended.

3. This order shall become effective on January 18, 2008.
