The Missouri Public Service Commission is shortening the time to file a response to the *Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff* (“motion”), filed on September 29, 2011. The tariff is effective October 10, 2011, which is a State holiday, so the last day for the Commission to act on it is October 7, 2011. The Commission has set the date for Staff’s recommendation at October 5, 2011. To have time act on the motion and recommendation, the Commission will shorten the time for responding to the motion accordingly.<sup>1</sup>

1. Any response to the *Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff* is due no later than October 5, 2011.
