1. Q. Please state your name and business address.
2. A. My name is Meade C. Seaman and my business address is
3. 19845 U.S. 31 North, Westfield, Indiana 46074.
4. Q. By whom are you employed?
5. A. I am employed by GTE North Incorporated ("GTE North"
6. or "Company").
7. Q. Are you the same Meade C. Seaman who filed direct
8. testimony for this case?
9. A. Yes, I am.
10. Q. What is the purpose of your rebuttal testimony?
11. A. The purpose of my rebuttal testimony is to respond to
12. portions of direct testimony, submitted on behalf of
13. the Office of the Public Counsel by M. Dianne
14. Drainer. Specifically, my rebuttal testimony has been
15. developed in response to Ms. Drainer's recommendation
16. that the Commission direct all Local Exchange Carriers
17. (LECs) to discontinue Billing and Collection services
18. for all unauthorized Alternative Operator Service
19. Providers (AOS) calls.
20. Q. On what basis does GTE provide for Ancillary Services,

1. including billing and collection services?
2. A. GTE provides Ancillary Services, including billing and
3. collection services, pursuant to its Facilities for
4. Intrastate Access Tariff P.S.C.M. No. 2, Section 8.
5. Specifically, Section 8.1.2 (A)(1)(a) makes available
6. the provision of Ancillary Services "to the
7. customer". Section 2.6 defines "customer" as "any
8. individual, partnership, association, joint stock
9. company, trust, corporation, or governmental entity or
10. any other entity which subscribes to the services
11. offered under this tariff, including Interexchange
12. Carriers (ICs), end users and Information Service
13. Providers." In other words, GTE's approved tariff
14. makes billing and collection services available to
15. anyone.
16. Q. Does GTE's tariff limit availability of billing and
17. collection services to certified companies?
18. A. No, it does not. GTE's Ancillary Services are made
19. available to anyone. The company presumes that any
20. customer ordering from this tariff is acting in a
21. lawful manner. The company does not view its role as
22. one of enforcement.
23. Q. Does this conclude your rebuttal testimony?
24. A. Yes, it does.
