This new rider filed by Union Electric Company-Rider P-PowerStat Program Rider, is experimental in nature. Such program will allow up to one hundred (100) residential customers located within the city limits of Jefferson City, Missouri, to purchase electricity in advance of use through a special metering device. More specifically, this Rider P will provide the Company with research information on the effectiveness and attractiveness of having customers pay for electricity in advance to allow them to buy electricity when they need it, on their own schedule, and in amounts they can afford.

Due to the orientation of this experimental program toward research, the provisions of this Rider P limit the number of participants in the program in order that maximum information can be obtained from such research at minimum cost.

POWERSTAT PROGRAM RIDER

1. Application

The PowerStat program (hereafter "program") applies to the advance purchase of electricity provided through a PowerStat metering device and a PowerCard, subject to the definitions and conditions below. The terms "PowerStat" and "PowerCard" are registered trademarks of CIC Systems, Inc.

2. Availability

This program is of an experimental nature and shall be a limited option to residential customers at dwelling units located within the city limits of Jefferson City, Mo. It shall have no more than 100 of such customers participating in the program at any one time, as approved and determined by the Company. The Company shall have the right to refuse any applicant from participating in the program.

3. <u>Definitions and Conditions</u>

All provisions and rates set forth in the Company's tariffs shall apply to the program except that the following provisions of its tariffs on Billing Practices shall not apply: Budget Billing Plan (Sheet Nos. 172-173); Deferred Pay Date Program (Sheet No. 173); Notice of Intent to Disconnect Residential Service (Sheet No. 181); Residential Customer Contact and Notice of Disconnection (Sheet No. 182); Disconnection Hours (Sheet No. 182); Delay of Disconnection for Medical Reasons (Sheet No. 182); and Avoidance of Disconnection of Service (Sheet No. 183).

Before any PowerStat equipment is installed, each participant shall sign an Agreement with the Company which sets forth the responsibilities of the Company and each participant. (See Form of Agreement following Section 5 of this rider.)

The Company shall add a PowerStat prepaid metering system to the participant's meter installation.

The applicable rate for this program shall be in accordance with the Company's residential tariffs.

A customer moving into a dwelling unit which has an existing PowerStat metering system may become a participant in the program, at the Company's discretion. If the Company elects not to allow such a customer to become a participant, the Company shall remove the PowerStat metering system.

When the participant is a tenant residing in rental property, the Company may require written concurrence from the property owner or its authorized agent that the tenant may participate in the program.

4. The PowerStat Program and the Cold Weather Rule

During the Cold Weather Period, from Movember 15 through March 31, all PowerCards shall be encoded to provide each participant with limited service of not less than 2,000 watts when the "amount remaining" display on the PowerStat unit reaches zero. Wattage shall be appropriately for participants with electric heating to a maximum of 15,500 watts. This limited electric service shall permit heating, lighting and refrigeration during the Cold Weather Period according to the following conditions. Any electric service used after the "amount remaining" reaches zero shall accumulate and show on the PowerStat display as a negative value. When additional service is purchased, the accumulated negative value shall be subtracted, and any balance shall show as the new "amount remaining". Participants with a negative balance are required to purchase one or more PowerCards in the value of the "amount remaining" or \$75 each 30 days, whichever is less, to avoid disconnection of service.

Termination

The Company reserves the right to terminate the program as of December 31, 1992.
