ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On May 12, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate of service authority of John Jay Rosacker, an individual that has been authorized to provide private payphone service by the Commission. Staff's motion states that it has received a FY-2005 Statement of Revenue from Rosacker indicating that he has not done business in Missouri since 2002. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority to provide private payphone services that has been issued to Rosacker. Rosacker has not responded to Staff's motion.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2004), which states, in part: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion, the statement included in that motion, and on Rosacker's failure to respond, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to John Jay Rosacker should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of authority to provide private payphone services granted to John Jay Rosacker in Case Number TA-2000-367 is canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on June 4, 2005.
3. That this case may be closed on June 5, 2005.
