ORDER NULLIFYING CERTIFICATES

Effective Date: June 16, 2007

On May 15, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to nullify and cancel the certificates of service authority of Trucomm Corporation to provide basic local, intrastate, interexchange telecommunications services and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services, limited to providing dedicated private line services in Missouri.

In Case Number CA-2004-0115, the Commission granted Trucomm a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services.

In Case Number XA-2004-0114, the Commission granted Trucomm a certificate to provide intrastate, interexchange telecommunications services and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services, limited to providing dedicated private line services.

In both cases, CA-2004-0115 and XA-2004-0114, the Commission waived Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C) and specified Trucomm may not operate in Missouri until the tariffs are submitted and approved by the Commission. Trucomm never filed proposed tariffs or interconnection agreements to provide the services granted by the Commission. Staff's motion states that Trucomm indicated in its confidential Statement of Revenue that it is not providing telecommunications services in Missouri. Trucomm also reported no Missouri jurisdictional revenue and no longer wishes to maintain its operating certificates in Missouri. Trucomm failed to file its annual registration report according the Missouri Secretary of State's office, and its authority to do business in the State of Missouri was revoked on March 14, 2006. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificates of service authority.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion and Trucomm's request, the Commission finds that the certificates of service authority granted to Trucomm Corporation shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in Missouri, granted to Trucomm Corporation in Case Number CA-2004-0115, is nullified and canceled.

2. The certificate of authority to provide intrastate, interexchange telecommunications services and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services, limited to providing dedicated private line services in Missouri, granted to Trucomm Corporation in Case Number XA-2004-0114, is nullified and canceled.

3. This order shall become effective on June 16, 2007.

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4. This case may be closed on June 17, 2007.
