## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

On July 14,<sup>1</sup> Access Point, Inc. ("API") filed an application requesting expansion of its certificate of service authority to provide competitive basic local exchange telecommunications throughout all of the exchanges of all Missouri incumbent local exchange companies. In conjunction with its application, API filed tariffs governing the provision of the proposed telecommunications services. Those tariffs bear the effective date of August 28.

On July 15, notice was issued and an intervention deadline was set for July 30. Because tariffs were filed with the application, and because the Commission would like to have the benefit of a recommendation from its Staff before it further considers API's application, the Commission will set a schedule for the filing of Staff's recommendation.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. In the event that no applications for intervention are filed, the Staff of the Missouri Public Commission shall file a recommendation regarding Access Point, Inc.'s application no later than August 14, 2009.
