ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR STAFF TO RESPOND

Easy Telephone Service Company, d/b/a Easy Wireless has applied for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) on a wireless basis. Although the Commission's Staff initially recommended the Commission grant Easy Telephone the designation it seeks, Staff withdrew that recommendation after receiving allegations of fraudulent activity by Easy Telephone or companies affiliated with Easy Telephone. On March 11, 2011, Easy Telephone filed extensive documentation in an attempt to refute the allegations of fraud. Staff requested, and was allowed, until April 1 to respond to Easy Telephone's additional documentation.

On April 1, Staff filed a motion explaining that because of time constraints, it has not yet completed its review. For that reason, Staff requests an additional ten days to file its response. The Commission will allow Staff the additional time it requests.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's Request for Extension of Time is granted
2. No later than April 11, 2011, Staff shall file an updated recommendation that replies to Easy Telephone Service Company, d/b/a Easy Wireless' March 11, 2011 response.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
