The tariff's effective date was September 25, but the applicant extended the filing date under the following provision:

When a public utility extends the effective date of a tariff, it shall file one (1) original, and eight (8) copies of a letter extending the tariff effective date in the official case file. Notwithstanding any other provision of these rules, this letter may be filed by a nonattorney. [4]

The applicant's letter extends the tariff's effective date to October 10. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

1. The Staff Request for Extension of Time is granted.
