CERTIFICATION TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES

On November 12, Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC (“the Company”) pursuant to Section 392.550, RSMo, filed an application for certificate of service authority to expand Basic Local Telecommunications Service, Non-Switched Local Telecommunications Service, and Interexchange Telecommunications Service in the following exchanges:

Creighton, East Lynne, Garden City, Clubb, Eolia, Florence, Greenville, Middletown, New Hartford, Patterson, Piedmont, Silex and Stover

The Commission has reviewed the application filed by the Company and finds that it and the attached affidavit comply with the filing requirements set forth in Section 392.550, RSMo. The affidavit attached to the application represents that the company has not had contact with the Office of the Commission about any substantive issue connected to the filing within 60 days before filing the application. On the basis of that representation, for good cause shown, the Commission will waive application of the pre-filing notice requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).

This order will be issued with less than a 30-day effective date to comply with Section 392.550, RSMo.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC is granted certification to provide Basic Local Telecommunications Service, Non-Switched Local Telecommunications Service, and Interexchange Telecommunications Service in the exchanges set forth in the affidavit attached to the application and restated above.
2. The pre-filing notice requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1) are waived.
3. This order shall become effective on November 27, 2021.
4. This file may be closed on November 28, 2021.
