Enclosed for filing on behalf of Missouri Gas Energy are an original and three (3) copies of P.S.C. MO. No. 1, Fourth Revised Sheet No. 24.32, canceling Third Revised Sheet No. 24.32. This tariff sheet bears an issue date of April 4, 2001, and a proposed effective date of May 1, 2001.

By this filing MGE proposes to make its summer adjustment to the Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Rate as permitted under the provisions of Sheet No. 24.10 of MGE's tariff. MGE is proposing to adjust the Current Cost of Gas Factor (C.C.G.) and Refund Factor.

The new PGA rate proposed in this filing is \$0.76129 per Ccf; the PGA Rate currently in effect is \$0.79337. The proposed change in the PGA Rate reflects a decrease of 0.03208 per Ccf. The change in the PGA Rate reflects a change in the C.C.G. of \$0.04668 per Ccf, from the current amount of \$0.78967 to the proposed amount of \$0.74299.

The proposed PGA Rate also reflects a change to the Refund Factor of \$0.01460 per Ccf, from the current Refund Factor of (\$0.01460) to the proposed Refund Factor of \$0.00.

The proposed adjustment has the net effect of decreasing revenues in MGE's service area by approximately \$21,497,235 annually. This represents an overall 4.04% decrease in revenues.

On a matter related to this tariff sheet submission, also filed on today's date is Missouri Gas Energy's Motion for Waiver Related to Its Summer PGA Filing.

Workpapers supporting the calculations performed in developing the proposed changes have been provided this date under separate cover letter to the Commission's Staff and The Office of the Public Counsel.
