STATUS REPORT AND MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT AND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COME NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") (collectively, the "Company") and hereby file its Status Report And Motion For Additional Time To File Stipulation And Agreement and Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, the Company states as follows:

- 1. On October 22, 2015, the Commission issued its *Order Suspending Procedural Schedule and Order Directing Filing* which directed that KCP&L and GMO file either a Stipulation and Agreement or a revised procedural schedule by October 30, 2015.
- 2. While it does not appear that a Unanimous Stipulation And Agreement will be possible at this time, the Company and Staff have reached a tentative agreement in principle that would address most of the issues in this proceeding. However, additional time (approximately one week) will be needed to draft and file a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
- 3. Following the filing of the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement by the Company and other signatory parties, the parties intend to file a proposed revised procedural schedule for the case.

4. The parties request that the Commission extend the deadline for filing a

Stipulation And Agreement by one week from October 30 to November 6, 2015, and allow the

parties to propose a revised procedural schedule no later than November 10, 2015.

5. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of the Public

Counsel, Brightergy, LLC, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, Earth Island Institute d/b/a

Renew Missouri, the National Housing Trust, West Side Housing Organization, Union Electric

Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Missouri Department of Economic Development-Division of

Energy, United for Missouri, Inc., and Natural Resources Defense Council have been apprised of

the contents of this status report and motion, and have indicated that they either support or do not

oppose.

WHEREFORE, the Company respectfully requests the Commission extend the deadline

for filing a Stipulation And Agreement by one week to November 6, 2015, and allow the parties

to propose a revised procedural schedule no later than November 10, 2015.
