**STATUS REPORT AND MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE STIPULATION
AND AGREEMENT AND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COME NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) (collectively, the “Company”) and hereby file its Status Report And Motion For Additional Time To File Stipulation And Agreement and Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, the Company states as follows:

1. On October 30, 2015, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Motion for Extension of Time to File Stipulation and Agreement and Procedural Schedule* which directed that KCP&L and GMO file a Stipulation and Agreement by November 6, 2015 and a joint revised procedural schedule by November 10, 2015.

2. The Company provided its draft of a Non-Unanimous Stipulation to the parties late on November 4th and the parties are still reviewing the document and providing revisions to the agreement. Additional time (approximately one week) will be needed to continue drafting and to file a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.

3. Following the filing of the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement by the Company and other signatory parties, the parties intend to file a proposed revised procedural schedule for the case.

4. The Company advises that although significant progress has been made in drafting a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, it will not be possible to file it today

(November 6, 2015). As such, in an effort to resolve as many issues as possible by agreement, the Company requests that the Commission extend the deadline for filing a Stipulation And Agreement by one week from November 6 to November 13, 2015, and allow the parties to propose a revised procedural schedule no later than November 17, 2015.

5. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, Brightergy, LLC, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri, the National Housing Trust, West Side Housing Organization, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Missouri Department of Economic Development-Division of Energy, United for Missouri, Inc., and Natural Resources Defense Council have been apprised of the contents of this status report and motion, and have indicated that they either support or do not oppose.

WHEREFORE, the Company respectfully requests the Commission extend the deadline for filing a Stipulation And Agreement by one week to November 13, 2015, and allow the parties to propose a revised procedural schedule no later than November 17, 2015.
