AMENDMENT TO JULY 5, 2012 STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT RESOLVING AMEREN MISSOURI'S MEEIA FILING

COME NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and the Office of the Public Counsel (together, the "Signatories") and present this Amendment to the July 5, 2012 Stipulation and Agreement ("Stipulation Amendment") to the Commission for the Commission's approval, and in support thereof respectfully state as follows:

1. On July 5, 2012, the Signatories submitted their Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (Stipulation) which resolved all issues in the case.

2. Part of the Stipulation (paragraph 10 on page 14) requires a separate line item on Ameren Missouri's bills that reads: "Energy Efficiency Investment Chg." This charge would first appear on Ameren Missouri's bills with the effective date of new rates in the Company's current rate case, File No. ER-2012-0166, which is January 2, 2013.

3. Since that time, Ameren Missouri has started the process of reprogramming its billing system to add the required language. As part of this process, Ameren Missouri has found the phrase to be too long to fit on some of its bills.

4. In order to resolve this problem, the Signatories agree that the line item on all bills shall read: "Energy Efficiency Invest Chg." This change will be made on all tariff sheets, to be filed as compliance tariff sheets in this case, which reference the line item language.

5. The Signatories agree that, along with filing this Stipulation Amendment, Ameren Missouri shall file a motion for expedited treatment so that the Missouri Public Service Commission has time to issue an order that is effective no later than January 2, 2013.

6. The following parties are not Signatories to this Stipulation Amendment but have indicated that they do not oppose: the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Natural Resources Defense Council, Sierra Club, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri, Kansas City Power & Light Company, Laclede Gas Company, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and Barnes-Jewish Hospital.
