MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES' STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE FOR STODDARD COUNTY SEWER CO., INC.

Stoddard County Sewer Co., Inc. (Stoddard County Sewer) has a history of chronic noncompliance with the Missouri Clean Water Law, its implementing regulations, and Missouri State Operating Permit (MSOP) No. MO-0096881. Based on Department inspections, Stoddard County Sewer's Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) has been poorly operated and maintained. Department inspectors have also concluded that the WWTP has exceeded the original design capacity and will have to be upgraded, replaced, or eliminated. Department staff also documented several bypasses of raw sewage from Stoddard County Sewer's wastewater collection system that were not reported to the Department by Stoddard County Sewer. The wastewater collection system will also need to be evaluated by an engineer and deficiencies corrected to eliminate bypasses.

The Department is not aware of any steps Stoddard County Sewer has taken to come into compliance with the Missouri Clean Water Law, its implementing regulations, or MSOP No. MO-0096881. It is the Department's understanding that Mr. Roger Owens has been operating Stoddard County Sewer's WWTP and has submitted monthly discharge monitoring reports to the department pursuant to the MSOP No. MO-0096881. It is also important to note that MSOP No. MO-0096881 expired by its own terms on June 15, 1999 and due to compliance and ownership issues has not been able to renew Stoddard County Sewer's MSOP.

The Department finds Stoddard County Sewer to be in significant non-compliance of the Missouri Clean Water Law its implementing regulation and MSOP No. MO-0096881 based upon the following:

- On April 26, 1999, operated, used or maintained a water contaminant source a bypass from a collection pipe which discharged to waters of the state, without a MSOP in violation of Sections 644.051.2 and 644.076.1, RSMo, and 10 CSR 20-6.010(1)(A) and (5)(A).
