The accompanying tariff sheet issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), is being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued October 17, 2011 to become effective on and after November 1, 2011.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect adjustments to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) and Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factors for the Company's Missouri service areas.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, will increase from 73.00¢/Ccf to 75.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase from 54.42¢/Ccf to 54.77¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area will increase from 84.00¢/Ccf to 89.01¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase from 55.67¢/Ccf to 56.02¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

We are enclosing workpapers supporting this filing with the copy of this filing being provided to the Staff. These work papers have been designated "Highly Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where Ameren Missouri must compete for its gas supplies. The Company requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
