These sheets are being issued March 25, 2009 to become effective on or after April 24, 2009.

These sheets initiate a Residential Energy Efficiency Tariff under which the Company plans to offer energy efficiency services through a number of programs. The first program under this tariff, the Lighting and Appliance Program, is included in this filing. Additional programs will be filed at later dates.

The programs and activities covered by this filing are those identified in the Company's Integrated Resource Plan in Case No. EO-2007-0409. Advance draft copies of this filing and supporting information have been discussed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC).

Expenses incurred by the Company associated with the provision of services under this tariff will be accumulated in Regulatory Asset Accounts, as authorized by the Commission in Case No. ER-2007-0002, for consideration in the normal rate making process. A budget of up to \$42.7 million has been allocated to programs under this tariff through September 30, 2011.

To assist in the review of this proposed tariff, the Company will submit supplemental information to the Commission Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel and coordinate meetings to educate Staff and OPC on the provisions of the program and to answer any questions or concerns.
