#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and for its recommendation respectfully states:

- 1. On May 19, 2006, Northwest Missouri Cellular Limited Partnership ("NWMC") filed an application with the Commission for approval of a negotiated amendment to its interconnection agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("amendment"). The underlying interconnection agreement has previously been filed with and approved by this Commission in Case No. TK-2005-0288.
- 2. Section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 provides that a State commission may only reject a negotiated agreement if it finds that the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. 47 U.S.C. § 252(e).
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff states that the proposed amendment does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the agreement, and is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.
- 4. Staff notes that NWMC has not submitted a serially numbered copy of the amendment pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.513(1)(B)1.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the amendment pursuant to the Act, direct the parties to submit a serially numbered copy of the amendment, and direct the parties to submit any modifications or amendments.
