ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On May 19, 2005, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order rejecting an interconnection agreement between Missouri RSA No. 5 Partnership, d/b/a Chariton Valley Wireless and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, L.P. d/b/a SBC Missouri. The effective date of the order was May 29, 2005. On May 27, 2005, SBC filed an application for rehearing.

In its application, SBC continues to argue, as it did in its response to the Staff of the Commission's recommendation that the Commission reject the interconnection agreement unless the parties submit the relevant transit traffic agreement, that SBC is under no obligation to facilitate transit traffic.

Section 386.500, RSMo 2000, states that "the Commission shall grant and hold such rehearing, if in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear" SBC has not

provided sufficient reason for the Commission to grant a rehearing, and the Commission will deny the application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Southwestern Bell Telephone L.P. d/b/a SBC Missouri's application for rehearing is denied.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on June 9, 2005.
 - 3. That this case may be closed on June 10, 2005.
