On October 4, 2005, Neutral Tandem-Missouri, LLC filed an application with the Commission for approval of an interconnection agreement with SBC Missouri under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. The Commission ordered its Staff to file its Recommendation no later than November 7.

On November 7, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Memorandum. Staff stated that it is discussing with Neutral Tandem the absence of a transiting traffic provision in the agreement, and asks the Commission to extend its deadline to November 17. Staff stated that Neutral Tandem does not object to Staff's request.

The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Motion for Extension of Time to File Memorandum is granted.
2. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its Recommendation no later than November 17, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on November 8, 2005.
