On June 22, 2006, Mark Twain Rural Telephone Company filed an interconnection agreement as directed by the Commission through arbitration. The Telecommunications Act of 1996 requires the Commission to act to approve or reject arbitrated agreement within 30 days after it is submitted. If the Commission does not act on the agreement, it is deemed approved.¹

Although the Staff of the Commission recommended that the Commission approve the agreement, the Commission allowed the agreement to go into effect by operation of law on July 22, 2006.

There remains no further action in this matter. Therefore, this case may be closed.
