On July 22, 2021, the Commission issued its *Order Setting Procedural Schedule*. That order set the evidentiary hearing for October 21-22, 2021, at the Commission’s office in the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Commission is adding the option for the parties and their witnesses to participate in the hearing virtually, by video conference via WebEx.

The Commission’s procedural order also indicated that exhibit numbers would be assigned and those are set out below. As directed in the July 22, 2021 order, each party shall prepare a list of exhibits it intends to offer and submit a copy of that list to every other party and to the regulatory law judge no later than October 19, 2021.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party or witness shall have the option of appearing and testifying virtually by WebEx at the evidentiary hearing.
2. No later than October 19, 2021, any party or witness wishing to participate in the hearing via WebEx shall provide their name and email address to the regulatory law judge at nancy.dippell@psc.mo.gov.
