ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TARIFF

On September 3, 1998, McImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc. (McImetro) filed a Motion for Additional Time to File Tariff (Motion). The Motion notes that on February 21, 1997, the Commission issued its Report and Order granting McImetro's application for certificates of service authority. In that Order, the Commission directed McImetro to file its tariffs within 30 days of the approval of an interconnection agreement. On August 4, 1998, the Commission's Order Approving Interconnection Agreement became effective in Case No. TO-98-200, regarding McImetro's first interconnection agreement, which concerns interconnection with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company. The Motion for Additional Time to File Tariff indicates that McImetro needs additional time to complete the preparation of its tariffs beyond the 30-day time period allowed in the Commission's Report and Order. McImetro indicates that it currently believes it will be able to complete the preparation of its tariffs by September 17, 1998.

The Commission has reviewed MCImetro's Motion and finds that the request to extend the deadline for the filing of the tariff from

September 3, 1998, to September 17, 1998, should be granted. The request is reasonable, and will not prejudice any party to this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion for Additional Time to File Tariff filed by MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., on September 3, 1998, is granted, and the deadline for filing the tariff is extended from September 3, 1998, to September 17, 1998.
 - 2. That this Order shall become effective on September 14, 1998.
