## ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

Shayne Sowers submitted a letter to the Missouri Public Service Commission on June 19, 1998, asking the Commission to cancel his payphone certificate. Shayne Sowers was granted the certificate on August 16, 1996, in Case No. TA-97-18. The Staff of the Commission advised the Commission that it had made contact with the certificate holder and that the certificate should be canceled because Shayne Sowers did not have an ongoing utility operation.

Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Shayne Sowers' letter and Staff's comments and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Shayne Sowers in Case No. TA-97-18 shall be canceled.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the private payphone certificate granted to Shayne Sowers in Case No. TA-97-18 is canceled.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 23, 1998.

3. That this case may be closed on July 24, 1998.
