ORDER FURTHER SUSPENDING TARIFF

On October 10, 1997, Green Hills Communications, Inc. (Green Hills) filed an application requesting a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri. Green Hills is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Green Hills Telephone Corporation (Green Hills Corp). On November 18, the Commission issued its Order Granting Intervention and Suspending Tariff. The tariff is currently suspended until April 30, 1998. The Commission finds that the tariff should be further suspended for an additional period of 30 days, to May 30.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed by Green Hills Communications, Inc. on October 10, 1997 is further suspended for an additional 30 days from April 30, 1998 to May 30, 1998.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 1998.
