ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FILING OF A TARIFF

Frontier Local Services, Inc. (Frontier) filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services on January 29, 1998. The Commission issued an Order on July 15 granting Frontier the requested service authority and requiring Frontier file a tariff governing the service within 30 days of the Commission's approval of an interconnection agreement with another telecommunications provider.

On May 29, Frontier and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed a joint application for approval of an interconnection agreement. This approval was granted by the Commission prior to its approval of Frontier's application for service authority to provide basic local telecommunication on July 15.

On August 17, Frontier filed a Motion for Extension of Time Before Which a Tariff Must be Filed requesting an extension of the deadline for submission of a tariff. Frontier indicated its current business plan did not anticipate it actually providing basic local telecommunications services in Missouri until approximately December

1998. Frontier also stated it had not planned on filing a tariff with the Commission until October 30. For this reason, Frontier asked the Commission to extend the deadline for filing a tariff to October 30. Frontier indicated it knew of no adverse impact to any party involved in the case that would be caused by the delay.

The Commission has considered Frontier's motion and finds it to be a reasonable request. The Commission will adopt the proposed filing date of October 30 and Frontier shall file a tariff governing its provision of basic local telecommunications services in Missouri on or before that date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Frontier shall file a tariff governing its provision of basic local telecommunications services in Missouri on or before October 30, 1998.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on August 28, 1998.
