Second Order Scheduling Hearing

On January 6, 1999, Cole County Circuit Court issued an order titled Order Denying Motions To Dismiss And Alternative Motion To Quash Writ Of Review. In response to that order, the Commission issued a notice on January 7 which canceled the evidentiary hearing set for January 12. However, on January 11, the Commission received from the Western District Court of Appeals its Stop Order in which jurisdiction over Case No. GR-98-140 was returned to the Missouri Public Service Commission.

The Commission intends to hear this case and resolve the remaining issues as soon as it may lawfully do so. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.110 the Commission is required to give ten days notice prior to the time set for an evidentiary hearing. In order to allow the parties adequate time to prepare for this hearing, the

Commission will observe the ten-day requirement and reschedule this evidentiary hearing for January 25, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Commission will convene the evidentiary rehearing at 9:00 a.m. January 25, 1999 in Room 520B.

3. That this order shall be effective on January 22, 1999.
