## ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF SHEETS

Business Telecom d/b/a BTI (BTI) submitted a tariff filing (File No. 9800119) to the Commission for approval on August 7, 1997, with an effective date of September 6. BTI's filing is designed to increase rates for its Directory Assistance, Travel Service, Travel Service Plus, Mileage Sensitive Operator Service Rates, and Operator Service Charges.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Suspend on September 2, stating that the tariff filing would violate Section 392.500.2, RSMo 1994, which permits a competitive telecommunications company to file rate increases only upon ten days written notice to all potentially affected customers. Staff stated that Staff members have requested copies of the customer notices from BTI representatives but no copies have been submitted. BTI also failed to respond to Staff's request that the company extend the effective date of its tariff sheets so proper notice can be given. Therefore, Staff argues that the tariff sheets should be suspended pending proper notification.

The Commission has reviewed BTI's tariff filing and Staff's motion, and finds that there are questions of fact and of compliance with

the applicable statutes that need to be resolved before the Commission can approve the proposed tariff sheets. However, the Commission does not wish to institute a protracted suspension period and fully contested procedure if the matter can be resolved more efficiently. Accordingly, the effective date of the proposed tariff sheets will be suspended for 60 days, until November 5, 1997. The company shall file with the Commission copies of the customer notices required by Section 392.500.2, RSMo 1994, describing the tariffed rate changes and indicating that those changes will become effective on or before November 5, 1997. Commission Staff shall review the material provided by the company and file a memorandum advising whether the Commission should approve the tariff sheets.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the effective date of the following tariff sheets, submitted on August 7, 1997, by Business Telecom d/b/a BTI is suspended to November 5, 1997, or until otherwise ordered by this Commission:

- 3. That the Staff of the Commission shall review the notices and tariff sheets and file its recommendation no later than October 6, 1997.
  - 4. That this order shall become effective on September 4, 1997.
