FINAL REPORT REGARDING MEDIATION

COMES NOW Mid-Missouri Telephone Company, pursuant to the Commission's May 9, 2002 Order in Case No. TC-2002-190, and submits its final Status Report regarding mediation in this docket.

- 1. On August 1, 2000, Mid-Missouri Telephone Company requested mediation.
- 2. By notice of August 8, 2000, the Commission required Southwestern Bell's response thereto not later than August 11, 2000.
- 3. On August 11, 2000, Southwestern Bell accepted mediation. At that time the Commission's Secretary and Chief Regulatory Law Judge verbally advised he would contact the University of Missouri's Law School Mediation Department and subsequently a mediator would schedule the first mediation session.
- 4. Having heard nothing from the mediator or from the Commission, Mid-Missouri Telephone Company on or about September 12, 2000, again contacted the Commission's Secretary and Chief Regulatory Law Judge, who thereupon received a September 12, 2000 e-mail from UMC Law School Mediator James Levin, who advised he was out of the country and would schedule a mediation as soon as he could.

Based upon this conversation, counsel for Mid-Missouri Telephone Company advised both counsel for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, and the Commission's Secretary and Chief Regulatory Law Judge that, in view of the most recent conversation with Mr. Levin, there would be no further scheduling efforts, there would be no initial mediation session, and mediation was thereby effectively terminated.

- 10. Since December, 2000, there has been no further conversations or discussions regarding scheduling an initial mediation session, and no such sessions have been conducted, and neither Southwestern Bell nor Mid-Missouri Telephone Company nor the mediator nor the Commission's Secretary and Chief Regulatory Law Judge have done anything further with respect to mediation since December, 2000, a period of about 17 months.
- 11. Mediation attempts have been unsuccessful, and mediation attempts have now been terminated.
