## **STATUS REPORT**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through counsel, as directed by the Commission's <u>Order Directing Staff to File Monthly Status Reports</u> and submits the following <u>Status Report</u> to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the Commission):

- 1. This report covers the period of September 1, 2009 through September 30, 2009 and serves as the "monthly status report" for that period. Staff will continue to file these reports on or around the last working day of each month unless directed to do otherwise.
- 2. In the <u>Status Report</u> filed by Staff on August 31, 2009, Staff reported that it had recently conveyed to the President of the newly-incorporated non-profit entities, the Black Oak Mountain Water Company and the Black Oak Mountain Sewer Company (collectively referred to as Black Oak Mountain Water and Sewer), that Staff required additional documentation in order to verify the current ability of Black Oak Mountain Water and Sewer to access the utility system-related facilities.
- 3. As of the filing of this <u>Status Report</u>, Staff has not received the necessary documentation. On September 28, 2009, Staff received an email from the President of Black Oak Mountain Water and Sewer demonstrating that he had made several attempts to contact necessary parties in Stone County, Missouri. On September 29, 2009, Staff received another email indicating

that officials from Stone County had requested additional information from Black Oak Mountain Water and Sewer. Staff is optimistic that this information can be provided expeditiously and thus that the documentation necessary for Staff to reach a recommendation in this matter can be obtained in the relatively near future.

WHEREFORE, Staff submits this Status Report for the Commission's information.
