ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

On February 23, 2005, Level 3 Communications, LLC and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a SBC Missouri submitted a negotiated interconnection agreement for the Commission's approval. The Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding that interconnection agreement on April 11.

Staff is concerned that Level 3 and SBC's interconnection agreement does not include terms governing transiting traffic. Staff believes that the failure to submit the transiting traffic agreement for the Commission's approval as part of the interconnection agreement might discriminate against carriers who are not part of the agreement and might be against the public interest. Staff recommends that Level 3 and SBC be given an opportunity to file the transit traffic provisions as an amendment to the interconnection agreement, or to explain why they should not be required to file such provisions. If the transit traffic provisions are not filed as an amendment to the interconnection agreement, Staff recommends that the Commission reject the agreement.

Under applicable law, the Commission must approve or reject the submitted interconnection agreement by May 24. As a result, prompt action is required. Therefore, Level 3 and SBC will be directed to respond to Staff's recommendation no later than April 18.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Level 3 Communications, LLC and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, LP d/b/a SBC Missouri shall file their response to Staff's Recommendation no later than April 18, 2005.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on April 12, 2005.
