## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CHANGE PREHEARING DATE

On April 23, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint against Sprint Communications Company, L.P. In response, Sprint filed an Answer, Motion to Dismiss and, In the Alternative, Request for Waiver. On July 6, The Commission set a prehearing conference for July 17.

On July 11, Sprint filed a Motion to Change Prehearing Date. Sprint explained that its counsel has a conflict on July 17, and that counsel prefers the Commission hold a prehearing conference on July 19. Further, Sprint explains that neither Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel objects to the motion.
