## ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Issue Date: May 18, 2009

Effective Date: May 18, 2009

The Missouri Public Service Commission is ordering Camarato Distributing, Inc., ("Camarato") to show cause why the Commission should not issue an order of default against Camarato.

On March 30, 2009, the Commission's staff ("Staff") filed the complaint. On April 1, 2009, the Commission issued an order requiring Camarato to file an answer no later than May 11, 2009. As of the date of this order, Camarato has filed no answer. Such facts support the entry of a default against Camarato:

If the respondent in a complaint case fails to file a timely answer, the complainant's averments may be deemed admitted and an order granting default entered. [<sup>1</sup>]

Before the Commission takes action under that provision, Camarato may show cause why the Commission should not do so.

To show cause why the Commission should not dismiss the complaint, Camarato must respond to this order by filing an answer and showing cause why the Commission should accept it out of time and not enter an order of default. If Camarato does so, the Commission may schedule a hearing to gather evidence on which to decide the complaint. If Camarato does not comply with this order, the Commission may deem the allegations in the complaint admitted and decide the case on that basis.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than June 2, 2009, Camarato Distributing, Inc., shall file an answer to the complaint and show cause why the Commission should accept the late filing and not issue an order of default against Camarato.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
