**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF APPLICATION, SETTING INTERVENTION
DEADLINE, AND DIRECTING FILING OF STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On June 6, 2012, AT&T Corp. (“ATTC”) and AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (“ATTSW”) filed a combined application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”), requesting that the Commission issue an order (1) granting ATTC a Certificate of Service Authority to provide local exchange, basic local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Missouri, (2) granting ATTC and all of its services competitive classification, (3) waiving the application and enforcement of certain statutes and rules, and (4) cancelling ATTSW’s certificates of service authority to provide local exchange, basic local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services. ATTC is a New York corporation, and ATTSW is a Delaware corporation, both with their principal places of business at One AT&T Way, Bedminster, New Jersey 07921.

The Commission will direct its Data Center to send notice as set out in the ordered paragraphs below. The Commission will also set a deadline for any applications to intervene and will direct the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice of this application to all telecommunications carriers certificated to operate in the state of Missouri.

2. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than July 12, 2012, with:
