On June 29, 2015, Conterra Ultra Broadband, LLC (Conterra) filed an application with the Commission for certificates of service to provide basic local exchange, non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri and to classify said services and the company as competitive. Conterra is a South Carolina limited liability company, with its principal place of business at 2101 Rexford Road, Suite 200E, Charlotte, North Carolina 28211. The applicant did not file tariffs with its application, but indicates it will file all necessary tariffs after it has executed interconnection agreements with the underlying ILECs.

The Commission will direct its Data Center to send notice as set out in the ordered paragraphs below. The Commission will also set a deadline for any applications to intervene and will direct the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice of this application to all telecommunications carriers certificated to operate in the state of Missouri.
2. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than July 15, 2015.
3. No later than July 22, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation regarding the application.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
