## ORDER GRANTING STAFF MOTION TO **AUTHORIZE MISSOURI USF SUPPORT**

Issue Date: June 7, 2021 Effective Date: July 7, 2021

On May 25, 2021, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Authorize MoUSF Support (Motion). In the Motion, Staff points out that the Commission granted Socket Telecom, LLC (Socket) authority to be designated as Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETC) on March 3, 2021. The order doing so, however, did not authorize Socket to receive Missouri Universal Service Fund (MoUSF) support. Staff now moves the Commission to authorize MoUSF support.

Under federal authority, the application is within the Commission's jurisdiction to decide. Since no law requires a hearing, this is a non-contested case. Non-contested cases do not require formal proceedings or hearings before the Commission, and as such, there is no evidentiary record.<sup>3</sup> Consequently, the Commission bases its decision on the verified filings.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Socket is authorized to receive MoUSF low-income and disabled program support.
  - 2. This order shall become effective on July 7, 2021.
  - 3. This file shall be closed on July 8, 2021.
