Dear Mr. Secretary:

I am enclosing for filing with the Commission an original and three copies of revised tariff sheets that include rate and language changes reflected in an <u>Agreement</u> <u>Regarding Disposition of Small Company Rate Increase Request</u> (Disposition Agreement) between the Taney County Utilities Corporation (Company) and the Commission Staff (Staff) regarding the above subject. The Company initiated the subject rate increase request on November 4, 2002, under the Commission's small company rate increase procedure, which has been superceded by the Commission's sewer utility small company rate increase procedure, and the request was assigned the above-referenced tracking number. The Disposition Agreement reflects a "settlement" between the Company and the Staff regarding all matters related to the Company's sewer service rate increase request.

Additionally, please be advised that it is my understanding that the Staff will be filing the above-referenced Disposition Agreement with the Commission once a formal rate case has been established pursuant to this tariff filing.

Consistent with the Company/Staff Disposition Agreement, the enclosed revised tariff sheets contain customer rates intended to produce a net increase of \$4,971.00 in the Company's annual operating revenues for its sewer service operations, and also contain proposed changes to some of the Company's special service charges and the addition of other special service charges. The Disposition Agreement also calls for the Commission's approval of revised depreciation rates for the Company, and contains provisions related to several improvements in the Company's overall business operations.

Since the Disposition Agreement is only between the Company and the Staff, the enclosed revised tariff sheets bear an effective date that is greater than 45 days from the

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issue date, as required by the applicable Commission rule. I am anticipating that the Office of the Public Counsel will request that a notice regarding the agreement between the Company and the Staff be sent to the Company's customers because of the magnitude of the proposed rate increase. If that occurs, I will provide a copy of the notice to the Staff for filing in the case papers.

Lastly, it is my understanding that the Staff will be providing additional information about the Company's rate increase request and the related Staff audit and investigation, for filing in the case papers following the establishment of the formal rate case related to this tariff filing.
