On August 17, 2011, R.D. Sewer Co., L.L.C. ("R.D. Sewer") filed its semi-annual status report. The Commission ordered the semi-annual reports in its Report and Order issued on October 23, 2008. That same order requires the Commission's Staff to conduct annual inspections and file inspection reports. The status reports have demonstrated improvement in R.D. Sewer's operations, and given the Commission's Staff is also monitoring the company, the Commission will discontinue the requirement for R.D. Sewer to file status reports.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The requirement that R.D. Sewer Co., L.L.C. file semi-annual reports is canceled.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
