Attachment to TA-2000-207 File No. 0000192 November 1, 1999

An Amendment to Application was filed on September 24, 1999, to request a certificate of authority to provide nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services. An Order Suspending Tariff was issued September 29, 1999, suspending the tariff to November 17, 1999.

Staff notes that the waiver lists in the Application and tariff do not match the Notice, in that the Notice does not include 4 CSR 240-35, which has not been previously approved for IXCs, or 392.210.2, which is routinely granted to IXCs.

Applicant requests a waiver of 4 CSR 240-35, which has not been previously approved for IXCs. In support of its request, Applicant states:

Worldwide Fiber will be providing service only to other carriers, and its service will be billed exclusively on an individual case basis through contracts. This service will be highly competitive and all of these ICB arrangements will contain customer-specific sensitive and proprietary information. In addition, the filing of all contracts with the Commission would be time-consuming and burdensome. Since waiver of this rule is routinely granted to competitive local exchange companies, Worldwide believes that it is also appropriate to grant waiver of this section to a competitive interexchange carrier.

Staff believes ICB rates for high capacity transport are acceptable as long as they are for services provided to other carriers and not end users. Staff notes that a waiver of 4 CSR 240-35 is routinely granted to competitive local exchange companies (CLECs) and believes that it is also appropriate to grant it for an IXC in this situation. For these reasons, Staff recommends the Commission approve this waiver.
