Subject: Staff Recommendation to Grant Temporary Certificate of Service Authority and to Expedite Determination of Granting of Final Certificate of Service Authority

Date: October 1, 1999

On September 20, 1999, Northeast Missouri Long Distance (NMLD), an affiliate of Northeast Missouri Rural Telephone Company (NMRTC), filed with the Commission an Application for Certificate of Service Authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA interexchange and basic interexchange telecommunications services. On the same date, NMLD also filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment of its Petition for modification of its ILDP plan. NMLD is seeking expedited treatment because of (1) the short time constraints created by the fact AT&T has not yet decided to provide 1+ intraLATA service; (2) the need to make modifications to NMRTC's ILDP plan before October 20, 1999; and (3) the necessity to give customers timely notification. NMLD requests expedited consideration and approval of its Application for Certificate of Service Authority and accompanying tariff on or before October 5, 1999.

In its Application for Certificate of Service Authority, NMLD seeks authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA interexchange and basic interexchange telecommunications services (toll services) within the state of Missouri, and the application requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company. NMLD states that approving its applications would promote competition and be in the public interest, and therefore, requests the Commission to waive the statutes and rules previously waived for other competitive interexchange carriers. NMLD's proposed tariff, with an effective date of October 21, 1999, sets forth the initial terms and conditions under which NMLD will provide interexchange services; and its proposed services and rate structures are similar to the offerings of existing interexchange carriers.

At the request of the Staff, NMLD filed an amended application on September 27, 1999, and submitted substitute tariff sheets on September 27 and 30, 1999, correcting typographical errors, language omissions, and inconsistent listing of waivers in the application and tariff.

The Staff has no objections to the application and tariff, as amended, and recommends the Commission issue an order to grant NMLD a temporary certificate of service authority to provide intraLATA and interLATA interexchange and basic interexchange telecommunications services. This temporary certificate would be in effect for a period that shall terminate on the earlier of the effective date of the Commission's final order ruling on the application for certificate of service authority or the one year anniversary of applicant's request for competitive classification and request for waiver of certain Missouri statues and Commission rules. If no parties intervene, Staff recommends the Commission to cancel the temporary certificate of service authority and issue a certificate of service authority.

If the Commission does not approve NMLD's application and tariff prior to October 5, 1999, NMRTC's customers who have not selected a primary intraLATA toll carrier (PIC) may be without 1+ intraLATA toll service. This fact, along with the fact that other parties have not had the opportunity to contest this application, is the primary reason Staff recommends issuance of a Temporary Certificate of Service Authority as the Commission is authorized to do so by §392.410.6, RSMo. Suppl. 1998. This statute provides:

The commission may issue a temporary certificate which shall remain in force not to exceed one year to assure maintenance of adequate service or to serve particular customers, without notice and hearing, pending the determination of an application for a certificate.
