

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant BCGI Communications Corp. (Applicant) a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440, RSMo 1994).
- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See §392.361.2 RSMo 1994). All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See §392.361.3 RSMo 1994).

- 3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Application. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo. (See §§ 392.361.3 and 392.420 RSMo 1994 and § 392.185 RSMo Supp. 1999).
- 4. The Applicant filed a supplement to its application on January 25, 2000 including a brief statement of the character of the business it performs.
- 5. Staff also notes that the Applicant has filed a substitute tariff sheet to delete a reference to waiver of 4 CSR 240-33.020 which the Applicant had not requested in its Application and to include 4 CSR 240-30.040 which was requested in the Application.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission grant BCGI Communications Corp. a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services, grant Applicant competitive classification, approve Applicant's proposed tariff, PSC MO No. 1 with a proposed effective date of February 13, 2000, and approve waivers listed in the Notice of Applications.

A Notice of Deficiency was issued January 13, 2000, requiring Applicant to submit a brief statement of the character of the business performed by Applicant. Applicant filed a Supplement to Application on January 25, 2000, in order to cure the deficiency.

Staff notes that the waiver list in Applicant's tariff included 4 CSR 240-33.020. This waiver was not requested in the Application. Also, the Notice stated that this rule cannot be waived. Applicant's tariff did not include 4 CSR 240-30.040, which was requested in the Application. Applicant submitted a substitute sheet to remove the first waiver and add the second waiver. Staff has reviewed the substitute sheet and finds it acceptable.
