Replacement Tariffs

DATE: December 16, 1999

On November 12, 1999, Frontier Telemanagement Inc. (FTI), a competitive telecommunications company, submitted a tariff filing to reflect its name change Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc. On November 15, 1999, Frontier Local Services, Inc. (FLSI) and Allnet Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Communications Services (FCS) filed tariffs to reflect that their names would be changing to Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. and Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc., respectively. FTI was certificated to provide basic local and local exchange telecommunications services in Case No. TA-98-161. FLSI was certificated to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service in Case No. TA-98-318. FCS provides interexchange telecommunications services under the authority granted to Allnet Communications Services, Inc. in Case No. TA-84-154. The fictitious name of Frontier Communications Services was added in Case No. TO-96-137.

All three filings propose to replace the existing tariffs with new tariffs that reflect the "Global Crossing" name. Each of the filings also contains the appropriate amended certificates of authority from the Missouri Secretary of State. In addition to the proposed name changes the tariffs also contained other revisions. FTI proposes to reduce local service rates, introduce private branch exchange (PBX) service, correct DID number group rates, and make minor textual revisions.

According to FTI officials, no customers were affected by the rate corrections. FLSI proposes to make a minor textual revision and increase the discount percentage for the Term Plan Waiver Policy. FCS proposes to eliminate check sheets from its tariff. In accordance with 392.500 RSMO., companies classified with competitive status are permitted to decrease rates after seven days notice to the Commission.

At the request of the Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff), substitute pages were submitted on December 10, 1999 in Case Nos. TO-2000-326 and TO-2000-328 and on December 15, 1999 in Case No. TO-2000-329. The effective date for each of the tariffs was extended to December 30, 1999. The Staff has no objections to the proposed tariff filings, as amended, and recommends that the Commission approve the following tariffs to become effective December 30, 1999:
