# STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and for its Recommendation states:

In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant Sprint Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Sprint ("Applicant") approval of an facilities-based interconnection, resale agreement with Premiere Network Services, Inc., pursuant to the terms of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, for the reasons stated therein.
