On October 15, 1999 CSI Corporation, d/b/a Missouri CSI Corp. (CSI) filed name change documents with the Secretary of State and became Univance Telecommunications, Inc. (Univance or Company). On December 23, 1999 Univance Telecommunications, Inc., a competitive interexchange carrier, filed a proposed tariff, Case No. TO-2000-388, to revise the Company's existing tariff so that the new name would be reflected in the tariff. The filing was on December 30, 1999. Univance refiled its case on January 12, 2000 and on February 8, 2000 the company filed a substitute sheet for every page in the tariff to correct for pagination errors and inadmissible changes in the text and requested that the effective date be extended to February 25, 2000.

The Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) notes that the former CSI was certificated by the Commission to provide competitive interexchange telecommunications services in Case No. TO-88-142. Staff also notes that the Company has filed evidence with the Commission that the appropriate change-of-name documents have been filed with the Missouri Secretary of State. Staff has examined the proposed tariff and found it to be substantially the same as the tariff that is currently in effect and has no objection to the proposed filing taking effect. Staff recommends the Commission approve the proposed tariff which is to take effect on February 25, 2000.
