ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On May 3, 2005, Damon Andersson filed a complaint against AmerenUE. According to the complaint, Mr. Andersson is not responsible for Ericka Walters' bill. AmerenUE denies his allegations. Staff filed a report on July 6 that stated that Mr. Andersson is responsible for the bill. In response to a Commission order, Mr. Andersson sent additional documents to support his claim.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. They should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct, the time necessary to complete discovery, and to prepare for hearing. The parties should also be prepared to name the witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing.

Also, the parties should be prepared to discuss the stipulation of facts not at issue. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

If the parties do not resolve their dispute, they shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That a prehearing conference will be held on August 10, 2005, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. That any party wishing to appear by telephone shall notify the Regulatory Law Judge by calling 573-751-7497 no later than 5:00 p.m., August 8, 2005.
3. That the parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than August 17, 2005.
4. That this order shall become effective on August 2, 2005.
