STAFF'S RESPONSE TO THE PETITION OF THE NORTH AMERICAN NUMBERING PLAN ADMINISTRATOR ON BEHALF OF THE MISSOURI TELECOMMUNICATIONS INDUSTRY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its response respectfully states:

- 1. On December 17, 1999, the North American Numbering Plan Administrator Neustar, Inc. (NANPA) filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) its Petition of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator on Behalf of the Missouri Telecommunications Industry.
- 2. In its Petition, NANPA requests the Commission approve the Industry's recommended relief plans and schedules for the 314 and 816 Numbering Plan Areas (NPA) no later than March 1, 2000.
- 3. While Staff recognizes the anticipated exhaustion dates for the 314 and 816 NPAs, Staff requests, given the press of already scheduled matters, that the Commission allow Staff until February 11, 2000, to investigate, prepare, and file its recommendation in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests that the Commission approve February 11, 2000 as the date by which Staff's recommendation in this case must be filed.
