## ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Socket Telecom, LLC and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, d/b/a CenturyLink and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyLink have reached a settlement of their complaints. On January 11, 2010, Socket and CenturyLink filed a Memorandum of Dismissal in which they dismiss all claims and counterclaims with prejudice, and ask the Commission to close this case.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116 provides that once evidence has been offered or prepared testimony filed, a complaint may be dismissed only by leave of the Commission. The Commission will grant that leave and will dismiss the complaint.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Socket Telecom, LLC's complaint against CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, d/b/a CenturyLink and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyLink, along with all related counterclaims, is dismissed.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
3. This file shall be closed on January 13, 2010.
